Registration and Fee:

1. Registration starting at **12:00 Noon**. Sight-in rifle from 12:30 – 1:00 PM. Competition begins at **1:00 PM**.
2. Fee: **\$15.00 (Club members & non-members)**

Match Dates: The fourth Sunday of each month rain or shine. (Except in November & December)

Yearly Awards:

1. Gift cards to be awarded by drawing. To be eligible you **MUST SHOOT IN A MINIMUM OF 7 OUT OF 12 MATCHES** during the year.
2. First place in each classification – First Place Trophy
3. Second place in each classification – Second Place Trophy

To be eligible for trophies and awards you **MUST SHOOT IN A MINIMUM OF 6 MATCHES** during the year.

Rifle Types:

1. **Single Shot Rifle** – Typical types such as: Original or reproductions of Sharps, Ballard's, Stevens, Browning High Wall, Remington Rolling Block or Springfield Trapdoor. (Exposed hammer required)
2. **Lever Action Rifle** – Typical types such as Marlin, Winchester, Rossi and Browning.

Caliber and Bullet Requirements:

1. Minimum of 30 caliber and a bullet weight of 158 grains or larger. Typical calibers used are 40-65, 45-70, 45-90, 45-110, 45-120, 50-70, 50-100, etc. for single shot rifles and 30-30, 38-55, .357 magnum, 45 LC, 45-70, etc. for lever-action rifles.
2. In all classes the bullet must be of lead alloy of cast or swaged construction. **NO JACKETED BULLETS.** Gas Checks will be allowed.
3. Paper patched bullets are allowed as long as the bullets are constructed per # 2 above.
4. The only sights allowed are iron sights. Global front and vernier ladder types in the rear are the most commonly seen at the competition.
5. Black Powder or Smokeless can be used as long as the velocities are such the impact does not cause damage to the targets. **1400 fps is the maximum muzzle velocity permitted.** The Match Director will rule on any questionable rifle - caliber combination.

Classifications: Match consists of 25 targets

1. **Class B:** 0 – 9 hits out of 25.
2. **Class A:** 10 – 16 hits out of 25.
3. **Class AA:** 17 – 21 hits out of 25.
4. **Class AAA:** 22 – 25 hits out of 25.

You must shoot 6 monthly matches in a classification to qualify for the end of year awards other than the draw rifle. If you shoot more than 6 matches, your top 6 scores will be used to tabulate your end of year scores.

Rifles and ammunition: Both supplied by competitors.

Supports: **No artificial support (such as sand bags) may be used to support the rear stock of the rifle.** Only the non-trigger hand may be used. **Shooting Cross Sticks will be used in the sitting bench rest position.** Normally a sufficient number of cross sticks will be available at the match but competitors may use their own shooting cross sticks.

Shooting Positions: 5 shots at each of the following positions / targets – 25 total per match

1. Position # 1:
100 yards at the 16" square target, standing, off-hand position. No supports
2. Position # 2:
100 yards at the 8" square target; bench rest, using bench top cross sticks for support.
3. Position # 3:
100 yards at 5" round target; bench rest, using bench top cross sticks for support.
4. Position # 4:
200 yards at the 15" square target, bench rest, using bench top cross sticks for support.
5. Position # 5:
200 yards at the 8" circle target, bench rest, using bench top cross sticks for support.
